Qualifications:

- (1) Be of good moral character.
- (2) Have acquired a bachelor's degree conferred by a college or university accredited by an organization by the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board.
- (3) Have either
 - (A) One year of graduate study in criminology, corrections, counseling, law, social work, psychology, sociology, or other field of instruction approved by TJJD; or
 - (B) One year in full-time paid or full-time un-paid casework, counseling, community, or group work:
 - (1) In social service, community, corrections, or a juvenile agency that deals with offenders or disadvantaged persons; and
 - (2) That provides the kind of experience necessary to meet this requirement, as determined by the Castro/Swisher Juvenile Board.

Criminal history background check is mandatory.

Applicants must have reliable transportation, liability insurance, and a valid driver's license.
